



Three Steps to applying for a Tourist/Business Vietnamese e-visa:

1. Fill out the form below completely and save it to your computer.
2. Scan the following documents for all e-visa types:
 - A color scan of the traveler's passport - 10KB - 300 KB PDF format
 - One recent passport style photo less than six months old. In color, no glasses, neutral expression 10KB - 1MB - 2" x 2" jpg format
3. Either email all documents to e-visa@passportvisaadvisors.com or securely upload by clicking [HERE](#)
4. Click the desired level of service and pay accordingly. We will receive notification of your purchase and you will receive a payment receipt for your records.

Description: Vietnam e-visa options include tourism or business single-entry 30-day validity or tourism or business multiple-entry 90-days validity. Both single and multiple entry are good for only 30 days in country.

Caution: Vietnam e-visas are valid for entry at a limited number of approved air, land, and sea ports including Cat Bi, Cam Ranh, Can Tho, Da Nang, Noi Bai, Phu Bai, Phu Quoc, and Tan Son Nhat International Airports.

Entry into any other port will require a traditional visa, loose leaf visa, or a visa upon arrival. Click [HERE](#) if this applies to you.

Service Selection/Payment

Vietnam offers single entry and multiple entry tourist/business visas. A single-entry visa, as it stated is valid for one entry and one exit from the country. A multiple entry visa will allow the traveler to enter Vietnam, travel/cruise to other country/countries and return to Vietnam.

Both single and multiple entry visas allow for only 30 days in country, whereas the multiple entry visa will allow for 30 days per entry over the ninety-day visa, however the single-entry visa expires 30 days from the Vietnam e-visa date.

Important Vietnam visas are valid from the date you listed on this questionnaire and not before. Be sure you know your date of travel and arrive in Vietnam on this date, or after, but never before this date. If your e-visa is issued on the 15th of the month, you can enter on the 15th of after, but never on the 14th or before.

Note: The user of this form can pay for multiple travelers at the same time and create multiple questionnaires and supporting documents to send to PVA.

Next Steps

Next for you:

1. Save this worksheet on your computer along with the traveler's color passport scan and recent color passport photo. Note: the photo must be no more than six months old and if you don't have a passport photo that meets this criterion have another person take a photo with a smartphone and upload. No glasses, neutral expression, on a white/off white background.
2. Use the link below to securely upload all documents. If you prefer, you can send your documents via e-visa@passportvisaadvisors.com, however this is not a secure way to send PII data.

On our end:

1. PVA will review all information, and we will be in contact if there is anything that needs to be discussed.
2. Once all information is approved, we will submit the traveler's information online, pay the required consular fees and advise when the e-visa is issued.
3. We will save the e-visa and upload it securely via our ShareFile server. The traveler will receive a notification to log in to our secure server to download the e-visa. If there are any issues, the traveler will need to contact us at e-visa@passportvisaadvisors.com to access the e-visa file.

Finally:

Print a few copies of the e-visa and distribute them throughout your luggage and on your person. It is highly recommended to save the e-visa on your laptop, phone, and other personal device as well.
